


D2L Assignments contain a built-in annotation toolbar that allows faculty to highlight, draw, create shapes, and write comments on student submissions.

Enabling/Disabling Annotations

From the Assignments listing, click the arrow beside the Assignment folder and select Edit
Folder.



2. On the right-hand side of that page, locate and select **Evaluation & Feedback**; check *Make annotation tools available for assessment.*




3. Click Save and Close.

3. Annotation tools will appear in the upper left and right sides of the document viewer. Click on each tool to enable and use it.
